

PSIG Conference 2011 – Napa, California



Golf Outing Information

The golf outing will be held Friday, May 26, 2011 after the conclusion of the conference. Tee times will start at 1:00 PM and will continue about every 8 minutes until all groups have begun play.

The site of this year's outing is the Eagle Vines Vineyards and Golf Club, located at 580 South Kelly Road, in American Canyon, about 10 miles south of the Silverado Resort. All registered golfers will receive a map as part of their registration materials. Please be sure to make contact with Jim Keiler in person at the conference before noon on Thursday, May 25th to indicate your preference, if any, for playing partners. A pairing sheet will be forwarded to the course pro on Thursday afternoon to set up carts for easy identification upon the PSIG group's arrival at the course.

Eagle Vines Golf Club is a highly rated public golf club designed by Johnny Miller's firm with a full service clubhouse. Please visit their website for additional information – www.eaglevinesgolfclub.com. To reach the club, follow the directions on the map provided to the club's entrance on South Kelly Road.

The fee collected by PSIG covers the greens fee, golf cart fee, range balls, lunch, and participation in a prize pool and post-round refreshments. Each golfer should contact the Eagle Vines pro shop at least one week in advance to reserve his or her set of clubs for the day of play. This will allow the pro shop time to prepare for our group and have the clubs available on the day of play and distributed to the carts. A reservation for a left-hand club set is especially important. You may contact the pro shop for club rental reservations at (707) 257-4470. Club rentals are \$50 plus tax for top of the line clubs.

The lunch provided will include a sandwich (choice of Turkey, Ham, or Roast Beef), chips, fruit, a candy bar, and a bottle of water. Sandwich choices will be updated on arrival in Napa. Other beverages, whether soft drinks or spirits, are at the golfers' expense. If other food items are necessary for dietary reasons, contact the club's catering manager through the number listed above.

Proper golf attire will be required for all participants. The Dress Code is as follows:

Men - No denim, must have collared golf shirts or Mock neck golf shirt. No cargo shorts are allowed. Shorts may not be more than 4 inches above the knee.

Women - No denim, must have collared or sleeved shirts. No cargo shorts are allowed. Shorts may not be more than 4 inches above the knee.

Only spike-less golf shoes or shoes with soft spikes are allowed.
