George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) and William P. Hobby Airport (HOU)

Houston is served by two major airports, George Bush Intercontinental Airport and William P. Hobby Airport. More information on the various airlines that service these airports can be found at either www.fly2houston.com/iah or www.fly2houston.com/hobby.

Ground Transportation (IAH)

Car Rental

A number of car rental agencies serve IAH. Advantage, Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, Hertz, National and Thrifty are housed at the Consolidated Rental Car Center. This facility is served by one bus system which will transport you from your terminal to the nearby facility. The buses are white and maroon marked "Rental Car Shuttle". Taxis

Taxi service is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at every terminal. Two or more passengers going to the same destination should only be charged one fare and rates are approximately \$100 to Galveston.

Galveston Limo Shuttle Service

The Galveston Limo shuttle runs to Galveston from 10:30 AM to 6:00 PM at approximately two hour intervals, and to IAH from 5:00 AM to 3:30 PM at approximately two hour intervals.

Details on your ground transport arrangements such as price, terms of payment, and availability must be confirmed with the transportation provider as part of your travel planning process.

Please check their IAH Schedule for exact times. The rate is \$55 per person one way, or \$100 round trip.

Ground Transportation (Hobby)

Car Rental

A number of car rental agencies serve Hobby. Advantage, Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, Hertz, National and Thrifty are located in the baggage claim area in the lower level in individual booths. Buses and shuttle vans operate between the terminal and the car company sites.

Taxis

Taxi service is available until the arrival of the last flight of the day. You may get a taxi at Curb Zone 3 outside the baggage claim area in the lower level. Two or more passengers going to the same destination should only be charged one fare and rates are approximately \$86 to Galveston.

Galveston Limo Shuttle Service

The Galveston Limo shuttle runs to Galveston from 9:30 AM to 7:00 PM at approximately two hour intervals, and to Hobby from 5:00 AM to 3:30 PM at approximately two hour intervals. Please check their Hobby Schedule for exact times. The rate is \$45 per person one way, or \$80 round trip.
